Comptroller and Auditor General at C&AG Jersey Audit Office

Lynn has served as the Comptroller and Auditor General (C&AG) for Jersey since 1 January 2020 providing independent assurance that public finances in Jersey are being regulated, controlled, and accounted for in line with the law. As C&AG she considers and reports to the States on the economy efficiency and effectiveness of the use of resources, improvements to internal controls and general corporate governance arrangements. She also appoints external auditors for the States and a number of other bodies. Prior to becoming C&AG, Lynn was a partner in PwC UK's Assurance practice, with over 30 years of public and private sector experience. Outside of her role as C&AG Lynn is a member of the International Public Sector Accounting Standards Board and is the chair the Financial Reporting Advisory Board (FRAB) to HM Treasury. She was awarded a CBE in 2024 for her public service work with FRAB.
