community safety issues
Promote collaboration
Reduce crime and reoffending
Ensure victims, witnesses, and affected communities receive
the support they need to recover and thrive

At its heart, BASC is about creating an island community where
people feel safe , protected from harm, and included—regardless
of who they are.
