- Insights from working alongside peers facing similar issues

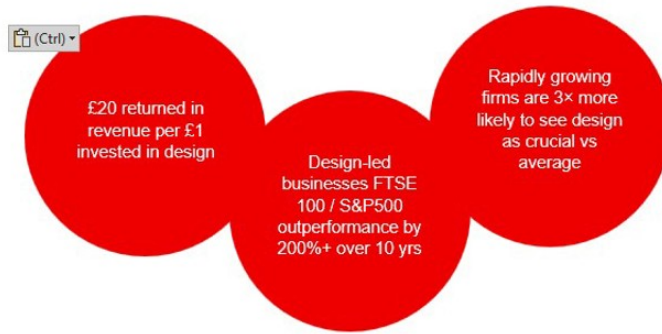
